

## Camp Carew Campers Should Bring

- Bedding: sleeping bag or traditional bedding (sheets, pillow, blankets).
- Clothing: plain everyday clothes. a sweater, raincoat or poncho, and an extra pair of shoes. (Flip-flops shouldn't be your primary shoes.)
- Toilet articles: towel, wash cloth, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Recreation materials: swimsuit, ball glove, camera, fishing pole, flashlight, etc.
- Education supplies: notebook, pencil, and Bible.
- The health profile section of the online registration process contains a download of a document that needs to be filled out by your physician. If you do not scan and upload this signed form to CampDoc.com, you **must** bring the signed form with you to camp.



## Camp Carew Campers Should NOT Bring

Because there are so many exciting things to do at Camp Carew, there are a few things that we ask campers to leave at home. If any of these things accidentally make it to camp, you can send them home with your parents at registration, or we can keep them securely in the camp office until it's time to head home.

**However**, if we find someone has brought a controlled substance to camp, the item will be confiscated and further action may be required.

- Screens: computers, electronic organizers, televisions, electronic games, etc.
- Music boxes: radios, CD players, iPods, etc.
- Weapons and weapon-like objects: knives, guns, fireworks, water guns, etc.
- Outside edibles: candy, snacks, food or drink from home, etc.
- Controlled substances: alcohol, illegal drugs, etc. **These items will be confiscated and further action may be required.**
