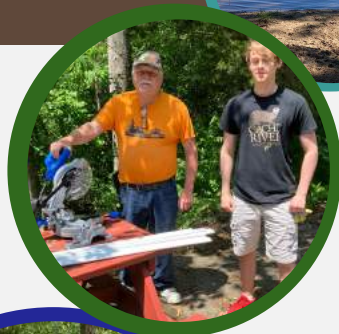

Mini Camp


3rd & 4th Grade

HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND INSURANCE

- A health form is required by our camp. The form can be found with your registration materials on the registration website. Please make sure it is completely filled out and signed. A NEW FORM MUST BE FILLED OUT EACH YEAR. ON FILE IS NO LONGER ACCEPTED! Campers can not be admitted to camp without completed forms!
- We recommend to parents and guardians that you have health insurance for the young people who come to camp. Please list your policy number or Medicaid number on the health forms. Camp Carew does not provide insurance coverage for campers.

CAMP STARTING AND ENDING TIMES

- Most camps start at 4 pm on Sundays.
- Please register after 4 pm.
- The camp gates do not open until 4 pm on Sundays.
- The weekly camps end on Saturdays at 9 am. Except PHOTOGRAPHY CAMP which ends at 4pm Friday.
- Mini camps begin on Sundays at 4 pm and end on Wednesdays at 1 pm.
- Day Camps are Monday through Friday from 9 am—4 pm. Please register after 8: 50 am on the first Monday of Day Camp.

REGISTRATION POLICY

- Please see website for registration campcarew.org
- ALL money including General horseback fees should be paid on our registration page.
- Deposits are \$50.
- Deposits received by May 15, 2024, will receive the early registration discount.
- June camp fees must be postmarked by June 1, 2024, and July camp fees postmarked by July 1, 2024, or a \$25 late fee will be charged.
- There will be no end-of-summer billing. All fees must be paid as stated above.
- Health and all other forms (completely filled out), should be filled out online, there is a link from our website campcarew.org
- NO registrations at the door.
- Each camp is limited to 16 campers.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- There is no refund on the \$50 deposit.
- 50% of camper fees can be refunded if a cancellation is made prior to the last two weeks before a camp begins.
- Cancellation less than two weeks prior to camp will result in no refund.

FEES

- A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit is required upon registration for all camps. Make payment at campcarew.org.
- The balance of the fee is due by the first of the month of your chosen camp. If you are requesting a scholarship, you must still include the deposit.
- Read carefully and complete the registration form provided. Sign up for the camp online thru the link at campcarew.org

Please note: Each unit camp is limited to 16 campers, so register early!

Early Registration Bonus: Registrations mailed by May 15th will receive a discount.

\$10.00 discount for week-long camps.

\$20.00 discount for first-time campers (excluding day campers).

\$5.00 discount for C.I.T., L.I.T., Day and Mini camps.

Scholarships are available for camps.

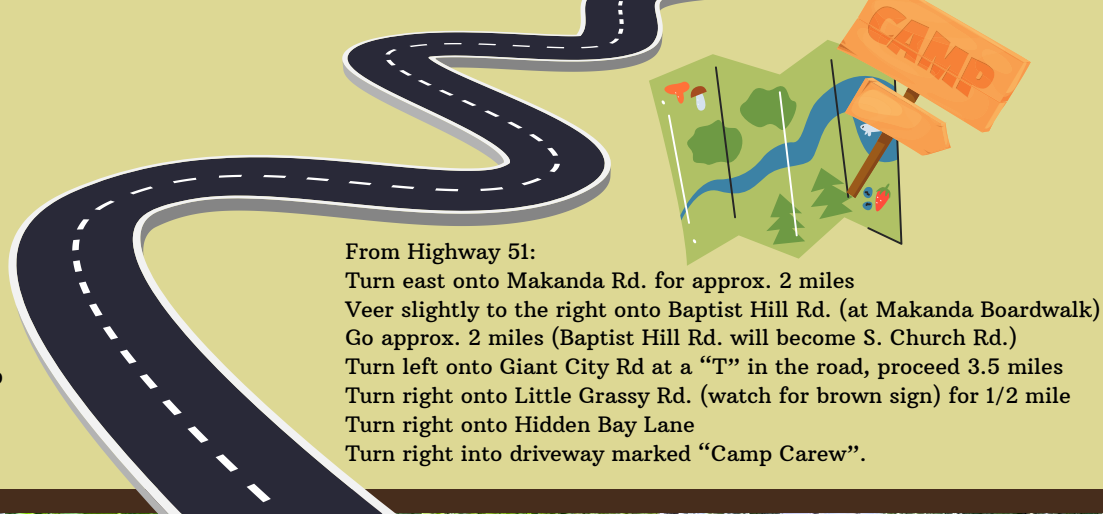

From Interstate 57:
Exit 54B at Marion and travel west on
Hwy. 13 approx. 15 miles to the east
side of Carbondale
Turn left onto Giant City Rd.
Travel south approx. 7 miles
Turn left onto Little Grassy Rd (watch
for brown sign)
Travel for 1/2 mile
Turn right onto Hidden Bay Lane.
Turn right into driveway marked "Camp
Carew".



From Highway 51:
Turn east onto Makanda Rd. for approx. 2 miles
Veer slightly to the right onto Baptist Hill Rd. (at Makanda Boardwalk)
Go approx. 2 miles (Baptist Hill Rd. will become S. Church Rd.)
Turn left onto Giant City Rd at a "T" in the road, proceed 3.5 miles
Turn right onto Little Grassy Rd. (watch for brown sign) for 1/2 mile
Turn right onto Hidden Bay Lane
Turn right into driveway marked "Camp Carew".
