Camp Carew Campers Should Bring These

- **Bedding:** sleeping bag or traditional bedding (sheets, pillow, blankets)
- **Clothing:** plain everyday clothes, sweater or sweatshirt, raincoat or poncho, swimsuit, and extra pair of shoes (Open-toe shoes or sandals shouldn't be your primary shoes.)
- **Hygiene Articles:** towel, wash cloth, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- **Education Materials:** Bible, camera, notebook and pencil, etc.
- **Health Profile:** your online registration process contains a form that you'll need to download and have signed by your physician. If you do not scan and upload this signed form to CampDoc.com, you must bring the signed form with you to camp.

Camp Carew Campers May Bring These

- **Recreational Equipment:** yo-yo, hacky sack, fishing pole (if you don't wish to use one of ours), etc.
- **Outdoor Conveniences:** water bottle, flashlight, sunglasses, hat with a brim (especially helpful when boating on sunny days), bug spray, sun screen, etc.

Camp Carew Campers Must NOT Bring These

Because there are so many exciting things to do at Camp Carew, there are a few things that we ask campers to leave at home. If one of these things accidentally makes it to camp, you can send it home with your parents, or we can keep it securely in the office until camp ends.

- **Telephones or other electronic distractions:** radios, CD players, iPods, etc.
- **Weapons or weapon-like objects:** knives, guns, water guns, fireworks, etc.
- **Outside Food:** candy, snacks, or drink from home, etc.
- **Controlled substances:** tobacco, alcohol, marijuana, illegal drugs, etc.

If we find someone has brought a controlled substance to Camp Carew, the substance will be confiscated and further action may be required.
